Art supply list for Mrs. Bailey

This supply list is used for all art classes, at all levels.

Items can be purchased from 2014 Blick art materials catalogue

The item numbers appear in parenthesis. You can put that number in the search area on the Dick Blick web site and it will take you right to that item. The page numbers are for the 2014 catalog. If ordering from the catalog put a B in front of the number.

(If you have a co-op or supply store that is cheaper, please feel free to purchase the supplies at the lower price.)

These art supplies are the same for all art levels. Art 2-4 will always use the 18 x24 paper.

For the classroom:

Pencil sharpener

Tissues (A box for the class should be in the room at all times)

Paper Towels

Masking tape- (1 inch office supply), 4 rolls per student – this is used to tape down work and for sculpture. Get this at your school co-op as it will be cheaper.

24 inch metal ruler (one for each student)(55430-1024) \$2.50 per item. Page 349

Compass (one for each student)(55437-0000) This is a safety compass. \$1.53 per item. Page 361

Old magazines for pictures and collages

Cardboard – (I save some boxes from the grocery store and let the kids cut these up. The cardboard is for 3-D construction)

Scissors (one per student)

Stapler and staples (the stapler must be able to open to lie flat so that staples can be put into the wooden board) One for the room.

Clear package tape – 2 inches wide/2 rolls per student. This is used for sculpting. (Dick Blick calls it book tape 2 inches / (23021-1002) \$7.57 page 193.

Glue – sticks or liquid – Elmer's and rubber cement.

Student drawing/painting board- A board to tape work to. You can get a large <u>form core</u> board from Hobby lobby for \$6.00 per sheet. This can be cut in half with a knife. Price per student is then \$3.00 a piece. Only one is needed per student. I use a <u>hardboard</u> that is 2 feet by 2 feet square. It comes to about \$1.50 per student. I call ahead to make sure they have some cut. (This is used to keep the work flat. I use the hardboard as it lasts longer – doesn't dent. The student can tape down paper for drawing or painting.)Only one board is needed per student.

1 large package of Styrofoam plates (used as paint pallets and for printing) I use the Styrofoam to make carved stamps and palettes.

Gallon ice cream pails or butter tubs (used for water – should have 1 per every 2 students)

Paper products

Art tissue paper – various colors

Construction paper – assorted colors

Plain ream of regular paper that one uses in a copy machine. Size – 8 ½ x 11 inches. This is used for sketches.

Ream of white cover stock paper- 65 lbs or 110 lb in weight. Size -8 % x 11 inches. This can be purchased at any Wall Mart, Staples, Office Supply store or Target. This will be used for inking, marker work and 3-D construction.

White poster or tag board – size – about 36x24 (each student will need two sheets at the start of the year) This next year the students will use a drawing paper instead of the tag board. See below.

1 ream of 18 x24,- 80 lb white sulphate drawing paper, (100 sheet ream 10209-1049 \$13.88, 500 sheet ream 10209-1039 \$61.78) page 214

1 ream of 12 X 18 -80 lb. White sulphate drawing paper, (100 sheet ream 10209-1079 \$5.47, 500 sheet ream 10209-1078 \$25.95) page 214

Watercolor paper 140 lb - 11 x 15 - 12 sheets per student (pad of 12 sheets -10107-1005, \$8.51 page 174) This is for painting - watercolor and acrylic.

Black crescent 14 ply poster board – 22x28 (13113-2002)page 236- \$3.08 per sheet - 2 per student – This is used to mat pictures – the students will cut these to fit their picture. (If you have colored poster board at your school this can be used instead. Or black mat board 20x32)

Scratch art paper – 2 per student 8 1/2 x 11 (13506-2085) Page 197 - \$0.45

Black construction paper- use instead of scratch art paper and silhouette project.

Paints/colored media

Acrylic paint - colors, black, ultramarine blue, phthalo blue, yellow, red, magenta, and white. (Get a few extra white as that color is used to make tints also.) I get the Blickrylic paints. They have the 6 pack of pints mixing color set \$27.70 per set (00711-1039) One set per 6 students. This is hard to estimate as some students use more than others. I stress conservation, but these paints can't be saved once they are poured out.

Watercolor set – this is a school pan set, usually 8 colors / 1 set per student (00309-1029)\$4.64 per set, page 14

Oil pastel set – small set – 12 colors / 1 for every 4 students (20020-1209) Page 303, \$1.74

Soft pastel set – small set / 1 ever y 4 students (20016-1009)Page 306, \$ 4.71

Charcoal – compressed sticks (box of 10 - 20004-1004) 1 stick per student. Page 322. \$8.70 per 10 pack.

Charcoal – vine/ willow sticks (box of 50 – 20004-1045 Page 322. \$ 8.70 per box)

Crayons – 20103-0129 12 color pack – page 298 - \$1.50 per pack – I get some from wall mart in the summer when they are 10 cents a pack. 1 pack per 2 students.

Markers – assorted colors (8 color set 21218-1209) Page 297-\$3.40 per pack. One pack per student.

Black sharpies – Each student will use 4 to 5 of these per school year. (maybe more – I just keep these on hand.) These are cheaper through Office supply, Staples or your consortium.

1 bottle India ink per 3 students (21104-2004)Speed ball super black waterproof India ink. Page 350 \$3.17 per bottle.

Dick blick water soluble printing inks (blue – 40305-5004, yellow – 40305-4004. Red, 40305-3004, black - 40305-2004) \$4.17 per tube. These are 2.5 oz tubes. One set per class should be enough.

Other supplies

Sponges (sea sponges work best) / 1 sponge per 2 students (royal super value sponge set - 32934-0009 - \$5.29 page 500) I go to the paint department of Menards or Lowels and buy them. Plain kitchen sponges can also be used in a pinch.

Brayer for printing- one per class. soft hard rubber brayer – (40121-1004) 4 inch brayer – page 392 \$7.46

Plastic wrap – 1 roll from the grocery store will be enough for the class. (This is used to cover Styrofoam plate pallets and create watercolor texture.)

Brushes (an assortment of flat and round painting brushes 1 inch wide bristles and smaller)Brushes are very expensive. There is a 42 brush "slightly imperfect assorted set" for \$27.80 page 99.

Krylon workable fixative -1 can for the classroom (21703-1003)This is used for charcoal drawing. (or a can of hair spray)Page 330 - \$6.28

Scratch knife $\underline{\text{holders}}$ – 1 per student (box of 12 – 22952-1012)- used for scratch art and inking. Page 348 - \$5.36 per box

Scratch knife blades straight – 1 per student (14901-1110)- used for scratch art. Page 196 \$0.92 per blade. These are very blunt blades – should be safe for schools.

*Do not order the following knives if they are not allowed in your school.

*X – acto hobby knives 1 knife per student (57458-1001) Page 560 \$2.90 – used for scratch art and to cut cardboard.

*X- Acto knives replacement blades.#24 - 1 pack of 5 blades (57457-1005) Page560 \$1.60

Nib pen and nib pen holder for India ink or the student can use a paint brush (nib holder is the same holder for scratch art above), nibs-standard school nib - 20913-1056 #56 nib-page 348 \$1.10

Ivory soap bars for carving – two for each student

Wooden nail stick – found at drug stores or target, wall mart etc. – used to carve soap because it doesn't have to be washed like a knife. (One per student) If you can't find the nail sticks you can use the wooden stick used for scratch art. (scratch sticks pack of 25 – 22883-1025)page 196 #3.18 for a pack of 25 sticks.

If your school provides all of the supplies, please order the following for each student.

Each student needs the following:

Mechanical pencil – used for perspective drawing

Drawing pencils: 4H (22220-2042), 6B(22220-2061) -one of each -page 360 -\$0.90 per pencil.

1 kneaded eraser - the small size 1.25 x ¾ x ¼ (21502-2620) page 332 \$0.65 per eraser

2 Larger pink or white erasers

1 gray paper blending stump (22856-1048 this is a class pack) page 331 \$15.99 per class pack

1 tortillion (22855-1036 this is a class pack) page 331 \$2.99 per class pack

1 fine point felt tip pen (one of each color: blue, yellow, red and green) It is cheaper to go to Staples, Office Depot or your consortium.

2 fine point felt tip pen black -) It is cheaper to go to Staples, Office Depot or your consortium.

12 color Crayola colored pencils set – 1 set per student (20519-1009) page 312 \$2.82

12 watercolor Crayola pencils set - 1 set per student (20522-1009) page 310 \$3.29

2 sheets of white tag or poster board – size – about 36x24

Personal ruler – clear preferred.
