## Syllabus – Español 2 2016-2017 School Year

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**Required Materials for Students:** Text and \*workbook – *Exprésate (Level2)*, 1-inch 3 ring binder with loose leaf paper, folder, pencils, and red pens for making corrections

\*Your school might have just one copy of the workbook – <u>Cuaderno de Vocabulario y Gramática</u> from which to make copies \*A Spanish/English dictionary is optional

**Grading:** Grades will be based on total points, and will consist of daily assignments, daily participation points, assessments, projects, and unit tests. All points/grades will be posted on power school through the Great Western Network.

\*Late work – students will not receive full credit on work that is late.

Grade Scale: A 92-100 B 84-91 C 78-83 D 70 -77 F 69 and Below **Make-up Work:** Please let me know when you will be absent – that is, if you happen to know ahead of time. The number of days a student is absent is the number of days that will be allotted for making up work. Students may have a week to make up any missed quizzes and/or tests. It is your responsibility to keep track of your make- up work, and to let me and the ITV facilitator know when you will be able to make up quizzes or tests.

\*It is very important to get your make-up work done as soon as possible, as we will continue to move forward with new information. Also, remember, work that is not completed shows up on power school and can affect eligibility.

## Attendance
