Info - Signature Sheet for Schools interested in becoming members of GWN ITV Consortium

- 1. Annual membership per school site is set at \$6,000 per year.
- 2. Receiving sites will be billed the per pupil fee (This fee is set annually and is typically \$600 per student per full year class. (college classes are not billed, but rather tuition paid by students directly to colleges)
- 3. Sending sites (Where teacher is teaching from) will be reimbursed by GWN consortium. (\$5,000 per full year class as long as there are 5 or more receiving site students. (\$2,500 when less than 5 students)
- 4. Teachers will be paid (by GWN) a stipend of \$1400 (+\$100 for each additional receiving site).
- 5. Annual Membership Fees and Per pupil fees are billed by GWN in late September or early October and are to be paid prior to December of the current school year.
- 6. In order to take advantage of all of the classes available, schools should follow the master calendar and bell schedule as closely as possible. (Please review bell schedule / calendar on gwn web site)
- 7. Schools will follow the GWN handbook and agreements in regard to daily operations. These and other guidelines are located at the GWN web site at www.greatwesternnetwork.com
- 8. The GWN board meets at least twice per school year to discuss policy and conduct their business meeting.
- Scheduling of classes for GWN starts in mid January and typically is done by mid April.
- 10. GWN membership brings with it equipment troubleshooting, maintenance and repair at no additional cost to the school. Improvements, upgrades and support are available to all members as part of their member fees. All equipment associated with the ITV remains property of GWN should a member school decide to leave.
- 11. Should a member school decide to drop out of GWN, they must do so in a formal request to the GWN director. Notification must be done 1 year in advance so that GWN budget commitments can be completed.
