CURRICULUM

1 credit

Art I is a prerequisite for this course. Art II will introduce students to more specialized media and techniques than Art I, but will continue to emphasize creativity. The following areas of art will be covered:

1. A condensed review of the principles of design and the elements of art through a 30 page workbook and a test over that material.
2. Portrait drawing with pencil. Self-portraits will be the final project.
3. Designing and sculpting face masks with a historical background. Materials used will be plaster gauze and acrylic paints.
4. Charcoal and pastel drawing
5. Art history unit of periods of art and famous artists
6. Watercolor painting.
7. Cartooning
8. Colored pencil drawing
9. Acrylic painting on canvas board

The following need to be in the classroom at all times:

1. Constant supply of
paper towels
scotch tape
stapler and staples
copy machine paper
2. Two 5-gallon pails (unless you have a sink in the classroom)
3. 3 ice cream pails with covers (5 qt.)
4. A screwdriver (flat)

Please have a locked cupboard in the classroom for art supplies. Supplies are expensive and disappear quite easily if not under lock and key.

Please have some sort of individual shelving for students to put their artwork on from day to day (approximately 22 x28 and about 8 inches between when stacked). It saves a lot of misery and frustration for the students and me if we can have their artwork lock up also.

Please order one subscription to the ARTISTS MAGAZINE (Students do monthly reports from this). Please see that they start with the Sept., 2009, issue. Those schools who ordered it last year, make sure your subscription does not run out in the middle of the year). Subscription Service phone number is 1-800-333-0444. The magazine will be placed in your school library and cannot be checked out.

Those schools I taught last year for either Art I or Art II should have a lot of the items on hand from last year that you will not have to order again for this fall. For instance, if you ordered a ream (500 sheets) of paper last year, you should have plenty left for the 2009-2010 year and you will not need to order the pads of 24 sheets. If in doubt, please give me a call. There are several items that both classes use.

Feel free to order these items wherever you wish, but please check with me about brands and sizes if ordering something other than from **BLICK ART MATERIALS**. It is extremely important that students have these supplies in order to complete the requirements for the class. If you are thinking of deleting some supplies, please check with me.

I will be checking with you sometime this summer or before school starts this fall to make sure that you have supplies on hand for the new year. I will also be sending you beginning of the year materials for my students.
