(If you have a co-op or supply store that is cheaper, please feel free to purchase the supplies at the lower price.)

For the classroom:

Plain ream of copy paper for the room

Ream of white cover stock paper

Pencil sharpener

Tissues (A box for the class should be in the room at all times)

Masking tape

24 inch metal ruler (one for each student)

Compass (one for each student)

2 foot X 2 foot $\frac{3}{4}$ inch or $\frac{1}{2}$ inch wooden board (one for each student) I get these pre cut from Menards or Home Depot stores.

Stapler and staples (the stapler must be able to open to lie flat so that staples can be put into the wooden board) One per every 4 students.

1 large package of paper or Styrofoam plates (used as paint pallets)

Gallon ice cream pails (used for water – should have 1 per every 2 students)

Regular crochet cotton thread – at least four different colors – Ex. Black, white and your school colors. (One roll in each color should be enough for a class)

1 ream of 12 X 18 80 lb. White sulphite drawing paper, (100 sheet ream c10209-1079, 500 sheet ream c10209-1078)

1 pint for every 2 students of the following Arcrylic colors, black, ultramarine blue, phthalo blue, yellow, red, magenta, and white. (Get a few extra white as that color is used to make tints also.) I get the

Blickrylic paints. They have the 6 pack of pints mixing color set - basic colors c00711-1049 and the mixing colors c00711-1039

Sponges (sea sponges work best)

Brushes (an assortment of flat and round painting brushes)

Various colors of construction paper

Art tissue paper – various colors

Water color paper 140 lb – 11 x 15 – 6 sheets per student (pad of 12 sheets c10107-1005)

Gummed Kraft paper tape 2 inches wide – 1 per class (c24118-1002)

Elmers glue (glue sticks and some bottles)

Rubber cement – need some bottles with brushes in them and a refill can to refill the smaller bottles

Krylon workable fixative – 1 can for the classroom (c21703-1003)

Charcoal – compressed sticks (box of 10 - c20004-1004)

Scratch art paper – 2 per student 8 1/2 x 11 (c13506-2085)

Scratch knife holders – 1 per student (box of 12 – c22952-1012)

Scratch knife blades straight – 1 per student (c14901-1110)

Paper towels

X – acto hobby knives 1 knife per student (c57458-1001)

X- Acto knives replacement blades. – 1 pack of 5 blades (c57457-0005)

Crayons – for class room

Old magazines (for pictures and collages)

Scissors (One per student)

1 bottle India ink per student

Ivory soap bars for carving – one for each student

Wooden nail stick – found at drug stores or target, wall mart etc. – used to carve soap because it doesn't have to be washed like a knife. (One per student) If you can't find the nail sticks you can use the wooden stick used for scratch art. (scratch sticks pack of 25 – c22883-1025)

Each student needs the following:

Pencil (No 2 school pencil)

Drawing pencils: 4H (c20409-2042), 2H(c20409-2022), 4B (c20409-2041) 6B(c20409-2061) -one of each

1 kneaded eraser - the small size 1.25 x ¾ x ¼ (c21502-2620)

1 blending stump (c22856-1048 this is a class pack)

1 tortillion (c22855-1036 this is a class pack)

1 fine point felt tip pen (one of each color: blue, yellow, red and green)

2 fine point felt tip pen black

12 color Crayola colored pencils set – 1 set per student (c20004-1045)

12 watercolor Crayola pencils set - 1 set per student (c20522-1009)

1 sheet 22 X 28 railroad board

1 water color set - this is the school pan set, usually 8 colors

1 oil pastel set – small set – 12 colors

2 Black mat board 20 x 32

1 roll clear package tape (I get this from Wall mart, Target or Menards in economy packages. You can get it from the post office though it is expensive. Our school belongs to a co-op where I can get it cheaper.)
