Each school is to provide the following items to be in the classroom at all times:

Qty. Item

Color wheels (for each student)

1 pt Tempera paint in each of the following colors: red, yellow, blue, green, orange, violet, black, and white (may need 2 bottles if you have a lot of students)

1 pkg (each color) 18 X 24 assorted colors construction paper of construction paper (red, blue, yellow, green, orange, violet, black, white, brown & a few "muted" colors like tan etc.) tempera paint (blue, red, yellow, green, violet, orange, black and white)

1 ream 12 X 18, 90 lb. white sulphite drawing paper

1 pkg 18 x 24 (or larger) 90 lb. student grade watercolor paper

1 each HB, 2B, and 4B drawing pencils (per student)

1 set 24 color Faber-Castell colored pencils (per student)

1 bottle India ink

1 roll 1 inch masking tape (this can be from your office supplies)

2 sheets (per student) 20 X 32 inch black matt board (minimum order: 10 sheets)

1 18 inch cork back ruler (each student)

1 gum eraser (each student)

1 large package of paper plates (for mixing paint)

1 sheet 22 X 28 inch railroad board

1 ½ inch bristle brush

1 scissor for each student

Flowing ink pens

Assortment of stamps (angles, sports, ribbons etc.)

Ink and pad for stamping

Assorted colors of permanent markers

Assorted colors of water base markers

Assorted tissue paper (2 packages)

1 gallon and dispensers of Elmer's Glue

6 rubber cement bottles

Sharp scissors

Several small containers for water Example: margarine tubs)

1 package paper plates for mixing paint

Assorted sizes of brushes (both round and flat. Example: 1 set Dynasty brushes (must order from Triarco Art catalog)

Large 1 1/2 to 2 inch brushes for washes

8 lbs of Plaster of Paris (each student)

1 Large box of crayons

Large assortment of magazine (for photos)
